STOP, AVOID, PLAN

Mosquitos breed in water.

Remove standing water from around your home. It only takes a bottle cap worth of standing water to cause a mosquito population.

Common culprits that should be monitored regularly for standing water include

- clogged rain gutters,
- corrugated drain pipes,
- bird baths,
- pet bowls,
- trash & recycling bins,
- plant pots, and
- children's toys.

Adult Mosquito Control

Operations for the control of adult mosquitoes begin when surveillance mosquito population has been met and weather conditions are favorable. Adult mosquito populations are controlled by spraying an adulticide using helicopter aerial spraying in the early morning hours during months of June through August.
